The Center for Grief and Healing and Center for Children staff provide care and grief support for adults, teens, and children grieving the loss of a loved one. Whether a Hospice of the Piedmont family member or friend, or a community member, this care is provided at no cost -- thanks to the generous support of friends and neighbors in our community.

During this last year of challenges and change, our therapists began providing weekly support and counseling for children and families via telephone and videoconferencing. Bereavement staff, including counselors and volunteers, made over 3,500 calls and worked with 542 group participants --both in person and virtually after the COVID-19 pandemic spread to our community. Our Center for Children staff has been working with the National Alliance for Grieving Children, participating in webinars with special programs related to telehealth counseling to support children during this time of heightened anxiety and stress. Our staff will continue to expand their skills with grief counseling and art therapy for children via telephone and video conference.

Hospice of the Piedmont offers the only free grief support program in our service area, and your support ensures this care is available to everyone in need.

Built in 1901 and opened by Hospice of the Piedmont in 2004, our Hospice House is one of only two licensed, residential hospice facilities in the state of Virginia. Since opening, the stately Victorian home has long been known as a “community gem.” Hospice House was renovated prior to opening its doors to patients in November 2004, thanks to private philanthropy.
